### Photographs

The archives of the N.E.S.T. Special Collections include more than 200 photographs and images. These include original prints, negatives, copies from newspapers, lithographic plates and glass slides. Each photograph is indexed under the archival number starting with the letter "p".

Over 100 items have been digitized. Items P1 to P99 were digitized as part of the agreement between N.E.S.T. and [Hill Museum and Manuscript Library \(HMML\)](#) in 2009. A future project of N.E.S.T. is to reorder these images in order to group duplicates and arrange them according to chronological order (particularly for the photographs of the Annual Meeting of the Syria Mission). As such, the current index includes the index number, the given digital number, as well as the original roman numeral, which corresponds to a list entitled "Photographs in the Syria Mission Archives 10.35" that identifies many of the individuals in the photographs. Some images were donated as digital files.

This lists includes the index number, its current location (please list when ordering items), alternative numbers (if relevant), a title, date, a list of individuals in the photograph and the name of the photographer/studio when available. It is important to note that many of the first photographers in the region were Protestants, including the Sabunji family. Some missionaries, particularly Henry Harris Jessup and James Dennis were keen photographers, including photographs in their publications that are held by the N.E.S.T. Special Collections. Photographs that are available in digital form are indicated below. The digital images P1 to P99, P205 to P215, and P252 to P274 are located in the folder labelled Photographs and can be viewed on the desktop of the Librarian's Office computer in the N.E.S.T. Library.
